

What to Pack in Your Disney Parks Bag!

- Refillable water bottles although you can get a free large cup of ice water at any counter service restaurant, at any time with or without ordering a meal.
- Flavored drink packets it is so important to stay hydrated and if flavored water helps keep you drinking water, bring them!
- Water spritzer/fan combo
- Wet wipes for hands and face
- Rain ponchos chances are that it will rain while you are at Disney World so pack a poncho! Disney sells them in the shops but you can purchase cheap ones at your local dollar store. Don't let the rain ruin your trip!
- Antibacterial hand sanitizer
- Frogg Togg Lilly Pads or similar product can be re-soaked and re-used to keep cool.
- Personal portable mini fan
- Mini First Aid Kit with Bandaids, ointment, blister kit, pain meds there are first aid stations located throughout the park that have these items available but it's always nice to have one easily on hand when the blister gets to be too much!
- Sunglasses
- Hat
- Sunscreen
- Park Maps use the My Disney Experience App for real time wait times; character locations, restroom locations, etc.
- Portable phone charger although there are charging stations throughout the parks. Disney has free WiFi in the parks.
- Plastic zip bags to store phones on water rides, etc.
- Extra clothes for little ones/kids
- Towels to sit on during parades and/or to wipe off sweat, water, etc.
- Snacks, gum (gum is not sold anywhere at Disney Parks/Resort)
- Pennies and quarters for a cheap Penny Press souvenir
- Autograph books and pen or sharpie marker the bigger the pen, the better for our friends that have big paws or gloves!
- Activities to keep kids busy while waiting in line such as bubbles or games
- Glow sticks to add to the nighttime fun during parades and fireworks
- Socks extra pairs of socks help when your feet get soaked on a water ride! We use moisture wicking socks to help with overall comfort throughout the day to keep feet dry.
- Flip flops/change of shoes lifesaver at the end of the day!
- Camera
- Lanyard with your pin collections or to start a pin collection
